Troop 200 Overview

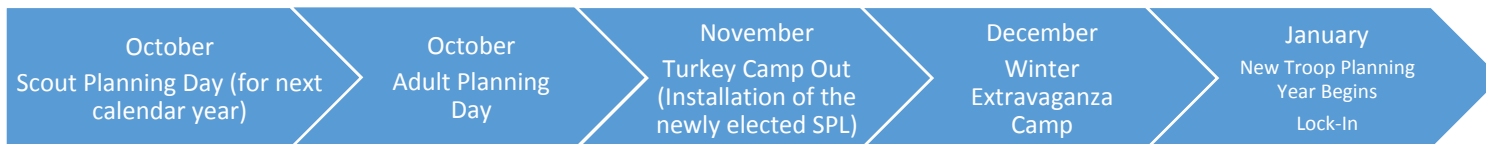
Northwest United Methodist Church

- 29 Life Scouts

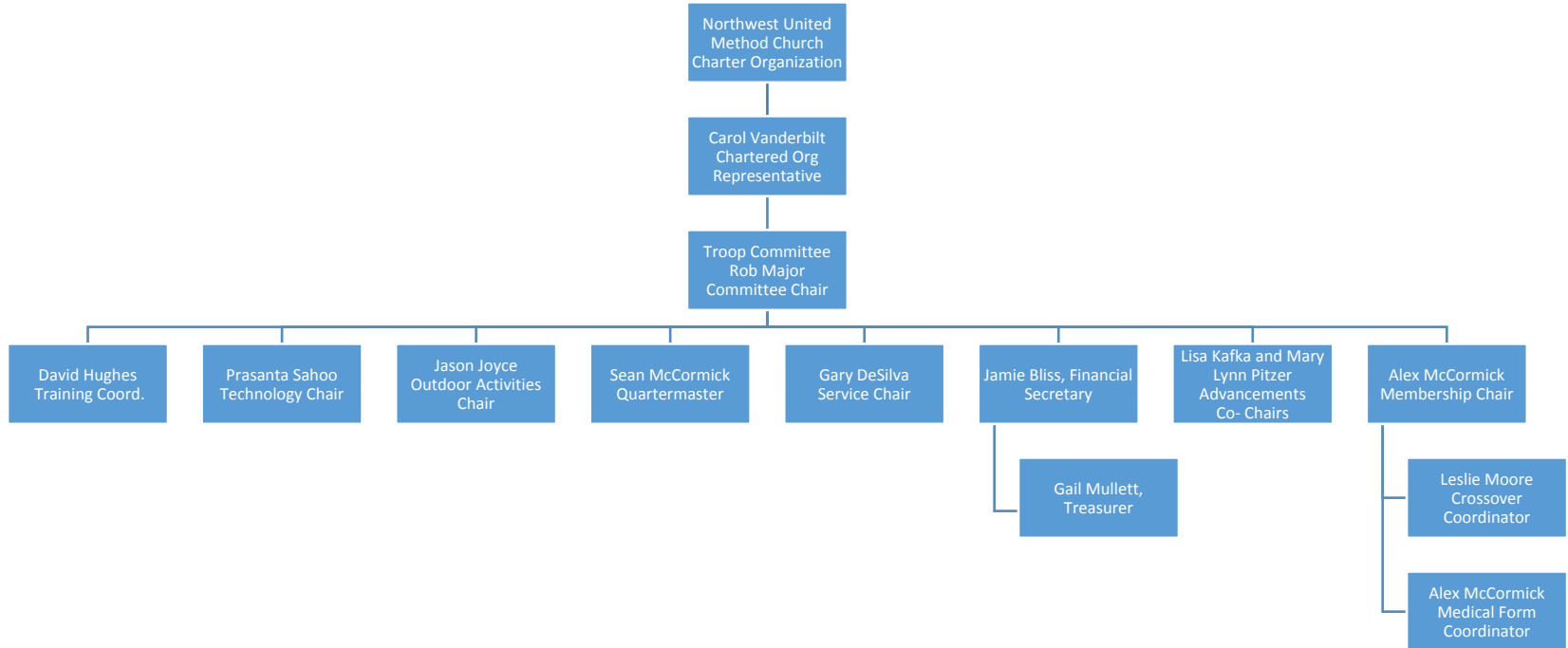


Troop 200 Annual Timeline

The Table - Sign-Up, Payments and Forms



- Sign-Up at the Table for Camp Outs, Scoutmaster Conference and other Troop Events
 - Sign-ups and decommitments for Campouts are due by the second Tuesday (Troop Meeting) prior to the Event
 - **No refunds issued for decommitments after the second Tuesday!**
 - Be sure to check with your Scout!

- Payments (Mrs. Mullett and/or Mrs. Timmons)
 - Payment is generally due at the time of Sign-Up
 - The Troop accepts cash, checks and credit card for payments less than \$100

- Forms (Mrs. McCormick)
 - Turn in and final check of Medical forms and applications and other T200 forms.
 - BSA Medical forms have expiration dates and lots of i's to dot and t's to cross.
 - Up-to-date Medical forms must be on file for your Scout to camp with T200.
- Scout Accounts (Mrs. Mullett and Mrs. Timmons)
 - Individual or Family accounts that can be used to pay for Troop activities
 - Add to your Scout Account at the Table or via Paypal T200Treasurer.cols.oh@gmail.com (link at troop200bsa.org)
 - Fundraising proceeds are deposited to your Scout Account

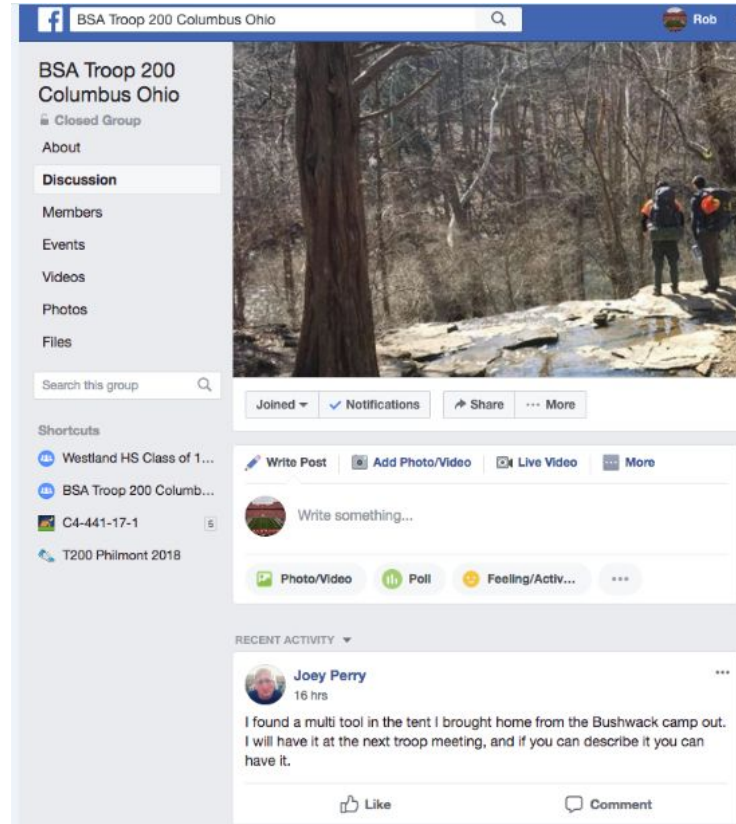
THIS WEEK
